

CERTIFICATION AND LICENSING PREPARATION

ADVANCED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN

For certified EMTs, WNC offers training for advanced preparation. Students learn to provide advanced emergency medical care for critical and emergent patients to reduce morbidity and mortality associated with trauma and traumatic emergencies.

EMT EMT training activities are scheduled on weekdays, evenings and weekends.

Course participants are instructed to have basic computer skills, including the ability to navigate various online learning programs.

Classroom activities are designed to assess skills, including the use of medical facilities.

Field experience is a requirement for all students. The Emergency Department requires a minimum of 100 hours of field experience. The program includes a minimum of 100 hours of field experience.

Students are required to pass a written exam and a practical exam.
