	<p>With these findings coming in, Lauren Stevens believed that building a webpage where students are able to refer when they need aid is a good option to use the money for.</p> <p>The Wildcat Wellness Webpage is up and running for WNC students, in-person or online, with a good amount of resources provided.</p> <p>This website has a 24/7 support line that consists of many licensed mental health professionals.</p> <p>There is a QR Code students can scan and it will call a helpline if needed.</p> <p>“Kognito is an interactive role-play simulation for students, faculty and staff to build awareness, knowledge and skills about mental health.”</p> <p>The website also has suggestions on wellness apps that can be installed on a cell phone.</p> <p>There is a Veteran Crisis chat that is free and is in service 24/7.</p> <p>There is a feature on the web page where students can find mental health professionals within the community.</p> <p>Lauren Stevens stated that they are open for new ideas to add on to the website.</p> <p>Counseling Services is now called the Academic Advising and Access.</p>

<b>Summary of Discussion</b>	<p>For the past few weeks, ASWN has been working on a Mental Health Resolution.</p> <p>ASWN members would like to discuss more about it with Lauren Stevens and receive input.</p> <p>Stevens mentioned short term classes (i.e., Summer Semester, Winter Semester, etc.) and how would the resolution be applied to those shorter classes.</p> <p>There is a system called Early Alert that alerts counselors about a student that an instructor has noticed any issues with them.</p> <p>This can include an excessive number of absences or low test scores.</p> <p>Instructors and counselors then work together to help the student get back on track.</p>
