	<hr/> <p>Students need a complete and submitted FAFSA to automatically receive funds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Citizenship</li> <li>- No convictions of drug offenses while using student federal aid.</li> <li>- etc.</li> </ul> <p>Completed checklist Satisfactory academic progress The level of enrollment will also impact the funds being rewarded to a student</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 3 credit enrollment is not valid</li> </ul> <p>Jumpstart students will not be rewarded</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Including exclusive online only scheduled students</li> </ul> <p>Targeting students who were forced to move to online classes and had a disruption or expense due to COVID-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 80% of funds will go to this targeted group of students - \$545,000</li> <li>- The other 20% is for the application process for students that aren't in the targeted group (a complete FAFSA will still be required)</li> <li>- DACA students can be eligible to other funds</li> </ul> <p>further explanation of academic progress requirement/components</p> <p>Cumulative GPA is overlooked (need 2.0 or higher)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Students cumulative completion rate (at least 67% completion rate)</li> <li>- Most recent semester completion rate (also 67%)</li> </ul> <p>Update on Fall 2020 funds No fall 2020 funds Have one year to spend the funds</p>

Nevada has joined the western state pack, how will that impact us?


Summer classes will remain online. However other semesters such as Fall aren't currently clear. A new level of Zoom can possibly be built for snow days for example. The goal is to have
